

TRAVEL BETWEEN Charles de Gaulle Airport and Paris-Bercy train station (at least 1 hour and 10 minutes journey time, better count 1 and 20 minutes especially from Terminal 2G)

☞ Reach the RER B station (suburban train)

From Terminals 1 and 3: the closest RER **B** station is *"Aéroport Charles de Gaulle 1"*

- From Terminal 1, it is available by free CDGVAL shuttle (journey time: 6 minutes)
- From Terminal 3, it is available by pedestrian walkway

From Terminal 2: the closest RER **B** station is *"Aéroport Charles de Gaulle 2 TGV"*

- From Terminals 2B, 2C, 2D, 2E and 2F, it is available on foot and by moving walkway
- From Terminal 2A, it is available on foot or by free N1 shuttle
- From Terminal 2G, it is available by free N2 shuttle, stop at "Terminal 2F", and then walk to RER station

At RER B station buy a **"Île-de-France (IDF) ticket"** (about 11,40€, may change ; these tickets are also called "point-to-point ticket", and can be purchased at ticket desks and automatic vending machines, located in (almost) all metro and RER stations ; if the price is about 2€, this is NOT the right kind of ticket).

- take the RER **B** towards "Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse"
- get off the RER **B** at the station "Châtelet-Les Halles"
- take the metro M **14**, towards "Olympiades"
- get off the M **14** at the station "Bercy"
- walk in Paris 5 min towards Bercy train station (see image below)



TRAVEL BETWEEN Paris-Bercy train station and Charles de Gaulle Airport

☞ From Paris-Bercy train station to Charles de Gaulle Airport Terminal 1 or 3

Leave Paris-Bercy train station, walk in Paris 5 min towards Bercy metro station **M** **14**.

At Bercy metro station, buy a "Île-de-France (IDF) ticket" (about 11,40€, may change ; these tickets are also called "point-to-point ticket", and can be purchased at ticket desks and automatic vending machines, located in (almost) all metro and RER stations ; If the price is about 2€, this is NOT the right kind of ticket).

- take the metro **M** **14**, towards "Saint-Lazare"
- get off the **M** **14** at the station "Châtelet-Les Halles"
- take the RER **B** towards "Aéroport Charles de Gaulle"
- get off the RER **B** at the station "Aéroport Charles de Gaulle 1"

- Terminal 1 is available by free CDGVAL shuttle (journey time: 6 minutes).
- Terminal 3 is available by pedestrian walkway.

☞ From Paris-Bercy train station to Charles de Gaulle Airport Terminal 2

Leave Paris-Bercy train station, walk in Paris 5 min towards Bercy metro station **M** **14**.

At Bercy metro station, buy a "Île-de-France (IDF) ticket" (about 11,40€, may change ; these tickets are also called "point-to-point ticket", and can be purchased at ticket desks and automatic vending machines, located in (almost) all metro and RER stations ; If the price is about 2€, this is NOT the right kind of ticket).

- take the metro **M** **14**, towards "Saint-Lazare"
- get off the **M** **14** at the station "Châtelet-Les Halles"
- take the RER **B** towards "Aéroport Charles de Gaulle"
- get off the RER **B** at the stop "Aéroport Charles de Gaulle 2 TGV"

- Terminals 2B, 2C, 2D, 2E et 2F are available by foot and by moving walkway.
- Terminal 2A is available by foot or by free N1 shuttle.
- Terminal 2G is available by free N2 shuttle, from Terminal 2F (that is, go to Terminal 2F by foot first, and then take the N2 shuttle towards Terminal 2G).
